NIDUS REGISTRY – Communication is key to self-determination!

The Nidus Registry, operated by the Nidus Resource Centre, is the only place in BC to register a Representation Agreement. You can also register any type of power of attorney. Many people use the Nidus Registry to securely store important information and documents and make them available to others who may need to know. The Nidus Registry has many features, like ‘sharing’ and wallet cards, to facilitate communication.
